



Silver Award Checklist

For troop leaders, advisors, family, and friends guiding Girl Scouts through the Silver Award process.

The Girl Scout Silver Award is the highest award a Cadette can achieve. Earning the Girl Scout Silver Award involves the time to complete a journey and then a suggested minimum of 50 hours.

Before you start, make sure the following are true/complete:

- Girl(s) are currently in grades 6, 7, or 8.
- Girl(s) have completed a Cadette Journey.
- Girl(s) and guiding adult(s) are registered Girl Scouts.
- Visit <u>girlscoutsiowa.org > About > Highest Awards > Silver Award</u> to download the girl and adult guidelines.

Girl Scout Silver Award Steps:

- 1. Girls identify an issue they care about.
- 2. Build your Girl Scout Silver Award team or decide to go solo.
 - Go through girl guidelines with all the girls participating.
 - Encourage friends, family and the community to get involved.
- 3. Explore your community!
- 4. Pick your Silver Award project.
 - Submit Silver Award Project Proposal.
 - o Please allow 4 weeks for review by Higher Awards Committee.
 - Receive approval or revisions from Higher Awards Committee before moving on.
- 5. Develop your project.
 - Submit Money Earning Project Application if applicable.
- 6. Put your plan into motion.
 - Be sure to take photos of your project!
- 7. Reflect, share your story, and celebrate!
 - Submit your <u>Silver Award Final Report</u>, including photos.

Silver Award projects should:

- Be sustainable. That means longlasting, so someone can continue the project once the girls have completed it!
- **Be girl-led.** That means based on the girls' interests and passions!
- Address a need in community.
- Reach beyond Girl Scouting to make the world a better place.
- Be completed individually or in small groups of 3-4 girls.

- Purchase Silver Award pins.
 - o If your *Silver Award Final Report* is turned in before Feb 1, the project will be honored at an annual Circle of Excellence event with a certificate for all girls.
- Celebrate with your troop and service unit!
