Make a tutu!

You will need:

3/8 inch elastic

bolts of tulle (Michael's)



Prep:

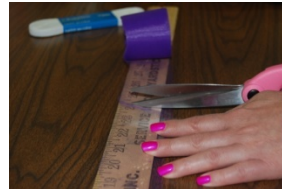
Remove cardboard from inside of tulle roll.



Measure roll into 3, 2" sections and cut.



Cut strips to desired length (18-24" depending on height of girls).



Separate colors into bags of 20 or so strips so that girls can choose different colors for their tutu.



Each tutu will require 3-5 bags of tulle.

***You can buy tulle at Hobby Lobby, but the cardboard is difficult to remove.**



Measure around each girls' waist and tie a knot.

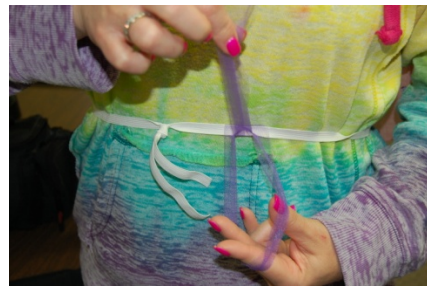


Have the girls help you now:

Fold a strip of tulle in half and slip it under your elastic.



Put the ends through the loop and pull through.



Keep doing that until your tutu is finished.



The program

After girls arrive we explain that fairies, brownies, and elves are very similar and all have a job to do.

Read the Brownie Elf story from the Girls Guide to Girl Scouts and have the girl recite the chant: "Twist me and turn me..."



The girls love to make fairy houses. These are simple wooden birdhouses purchased from a craft store and painted and decorated with jewels.

Have a fairy snack. Bread and butter with sprinkles, cupcakes with sprinkles, or strawberries on top of shortbread Girl Scout cookies with whipped cream are all wonderful fairy foods.
