



## HALL OF FAME GIRL SCOUTS OF GREATER IOWA

The Hall of Fame recognizes a lifetime commitment to the Girl Scout movement. No more than three individuals shall be inducted into the Hall of Fame in a given year.

Presentation should take place at the Annual Meeting or council-wide recognition event as deemed appropriate. The Hall of Fame Award may be given posthumously.

### **Criteria:**

1. The candidate must have a cumulative membership of 25 years or more as a registered adult Girl Scout.
2. The candidate must have been a previous recipient of the Thanks Badge or Greater Iowa Award.
3. The individual should be one who is recognized within the organization and the community as a truly outstanding Girl Scout.

### **Nomination:**

An individual or group familiar with the service performed submits an application or narrative account that documents the service and its scope and impact to the Recognition Task Group. Nominators should research information thoroughly, listing positions held by the candidate, previous awards, and an accurate account of service rendered.

Four individuals or groups familiar with the service performed submit narrative letters of endorsement to the Recognition Task Group. One of the endorsement letters must come from an individual or group outside of Girl Scouting.

### **Approval:**

The Recognition Task Group reviews the application or narrative account and letters of endorsement and recommends approval or denial to the Council Board of Directors.

Potential candidates for the Hall of Fame could be the following:

- A volunteer or staff person that has vast knowledge about this Girl Scout Council.
- A volunteer or staff person that is known throughout the council for her leadership and dedication.
