



TEAMWORK AWARD GIRL SCOUTS OF GREATER IOWA

The Teamwork Award recognizes two or more adult volunteers who exemplify what it means to work together as a team. .

The presentation is at a Service Unit Recognition Event. Girls from the troop/group should be included.

Criteria:

1. The candidates must be registered adult Girl Scouts.
2. The candidates should be recognized for their ability to work together.
3. The candidate's work with girls has exceeded expectations for the position and has served as a role model to the girls by living the Girl Scout Promise and Law.

Nomination:

An individual or group familiar with the service performed submits an application or narrative account that documents the service and its impact to the Recognition Task Group. Applications for both volunteers should be submitted together.

An additional individual or group familiar with the service performed by the team should submit narrative letters of endorsement to the Recognition Committee. Endorsements could include information from girls or young women who can attest to the candidate's positive influences; parents, or other Girl Scout members are also appropriate as endorsers.

Approval:

The Recognition Committee reviews the application or narrative account and letters of endorsement and recommends approval or denial to the Service Unit.

Potential candidates for the Teamwork Award could be the following.

- Co-leaders of a troop or group or two people sharing the Service Unit Manger position
- Co-chairs of a council-wide event or service unit special event.
