- Make sure that you have the proper gear: Washable/reusable gloves, trash bag, plenty of water, sunscreen, closed toe shoes, but spray, and clothing appropriate for the weather.

## READY TO START MAKING A DIFFERENCE? FOLLOW THESE STEPS TO LOG YOUR LITTER AND HELP US REACH OUR GOAL:

1. Download the [Litterati](#) app on your smartphone
2. Create an account.
3. You will then see your home dashboard. Click Challenges along the top banner. Scroll up until you see "Nearby Challenges. Click View All and then type Girl Scouts of Greater Iowa in the search bar.
4. Click the challenge and when it opens click the Participate button. Congratulations! You are now part of the challenge! All trash you log will automatically be logged under the challenge.
5. You can view the challenge progress by clicking Challenges along the top menu and scrolling down to your Saved Challenges.
6. You're now ready to start logging your community clean-up efforts. To log trash picked up around your neighborhood, click the camera icon. Photograph the trash. It will then confirm along the top of the screen that your logged trash photo has been uploaded.
