

# MAGAZINE BEADS

## BEFORE YOU GET STARTED

**Recommended Ages:** Grades K - 5

**Estimated Time:** 20 - 30 minutes

### Stuff you'll need:

- White School Glue
- Old Magazines
- Scissors
- Straw or Pencil
- Pipe cleaner/Yarn/String

**Caregivers should consider:** Girls should ask permission before using any materials.

## THE FUN PART

1. Cut strips out of colorful magazine pages. Try to keep the strips between ½” to 1” wide.
2. Start rolling a magazine strip firmly around the straw or pencil. Once it goes around one full time, put a few lines of glue down the inside length of the strip.
3. Begin rolling the magazine strip around the straw/pencil. Don't worry if glue squeezes out. Once the strip is completely wrapped, rub a small amount of glue around it to firmly secure the end.
4. Carefully slide it off the straw/pencil. Wipe off any excess glue on the straw/pencil.
5. Place beads on a paper plate or other surface to dry. Once the glue has dried, you can create your own bracelet, necklace, or other awesome piece of jewelry!
