Estimated Time: 20 - 30 minutes

Stuff you'll need: Paper and pencil

THE FUN PART

- Go on a nature walk and observe outdoor art. Try to find as many of these items as you can. Don't collect or touch anything – just observe!
 - □ An animal
 - □ A plant not colored green
 - □ A tree with flowers
 - □ An insect
 - □ A bird
 - \square A fallen leaf with a unique pattern
 - □ A rock with an unusual shape
 - □ A bush as tall as you
 - □ A pinecone or acorn
 - □ Moss growing on a rock or tree

- 2. Now find a nice spot to sit and observe the nature around you. Take note of what you see. Write down:
 - □ 5 things you can see
 - □ 4 things you can hear
 - □ 3 things you can smell
 - □ 2 things you can touch
- 3. Now create a poem, picture book, or art piece that illustrates what you observed.
