Learn about pandas Discover fun facts about Giant Pandas and their conservation.	Meditate like a panda Try a meditation activity focused on calmness, inspired by the peaceful nature of pandas. Teach someone about pandas

Connect with a conservationist

Watch a documentary or read about animal conservation then invite a conservationist to talk about local animal conservation.

Cultural cuisine exploration

Try making traditional Chinese recipes with your troop, friends, or family, appreciating where the panda is from.

Cookie-sharing challenge

Create a Cookie Share donation goal challenge for yourself and/or your troop.

Cookie customer care

Role-play different ways to engage with customers kindly and effectively, practicing empathy and listening skills.

Cookie superpowers

With your troop, family, or friends, talk about "superpowers" like kindness or creativity you might use during the cookie program.

Learn about popular cookies from around the world and taste with your troop or family! Do you have a favorite?

Panda-themed friendship bracelets

Make and exchange pandathemed friendship bracelets with your fellow GIrl Scouts to celebrate teamwork and the power of friendship.

Celebrate diversity in your community

Interview someone from a different culture. Be sure to ask for their story and about a time they've embraced possibility!

Create a panda dance routine

Work with a friend to come up with a fun dance routine inspired by panda moves, then perform it for your troop or at a cookie booth!

Cookie sales plan Create a business plan for the cookie season, including your goal, target customers, and strategies to achieve it.	Reduce, reuse, recycle Think about your own environmental impact and find ways to reuse cookie packages and cases. Can you use them in crafts, as storage, or something else? Be creative!	Make a plan to give back! Team up with your troop or family to volunteer at a local food pantry, animal shelter, or community organization.
Empower younger Girl Scouts Mentor a younger Girl Scout or troop, sharing cookie program tips and helping them set their own goals.	Plan a panda-themed event Host a panda-themed gathering to educate others about the importance of protecting wildlife and conservation efforts.	Write letters for change Write to local representatives or companies about conservation or community issues you care about.
Thank you cards for customers Design and send thank you cards to cookie customers, showing gratitude and building community.	Wildlife service project Organize an outing to clean a local park or trail, protecting natural habitats for animals in your area.
